Lucky Bamboo is considered good luck in feng shui when it represents all five feng shui elements:

Wood: the Bamboo itself

Earth: the Rocks the Bamboo grows in

Water: the Water the Bamboo grows with

 Fire: represented by a red ribbon or tie on the plant

 Metal: Glass pot the Bamboo grows in when planted in a clay or ceramic pot, a metal coin or figurine

The number of bamboo stalks in a pot symbolize:

- Happiness (3 stalks)
- Health (5 stalks)
- Love & Marriage (2 stalks)
- Wealth & Abundance (8 stalks)
- Good Fortune (9 stalks)



Lucky Bamboo Care Instructions

- Likes a temperature of 70-80°F during the day, and 60°F at night.
- Requires low light, keep out of direct sunlight to avoid scorching leaves.
- To water, submerge the bottom of bamboo stalks in 1-4" of water (depending on length of stalks).
- Change water every 10-14 days to develop a healthy root system (extra water as necessary on hot days).
- Be patient! It may take about 6 weeks to get some really good shoots going.
