# ARBORVITAE CARE QUICK TIPS:

- Planting location should receive at least 6 hours of sunlight and have well-drained soil. Amend your soil for proper planting.
- Follow a regular watering schedule during the first growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system. Once established, may be watered deeply, less frequently.
- Fertilize in the spring before new growth begins with a slow release fertilizer. We recommend feeding with 10-10-10 fertilizer.
- Though requiring little to no pruning, the low maintenance Arborvitaes should be pruned in early spring, if needed. Do not prune your first year.

# AMENDING YOUR SOIL

Clay Soil: (Heavy, poorly drained soil)
Plant with the following:
50% Compost & Manure
25% Enriched Top Soil
25% Existing Soil

Sandy Soil: (Well-drained or regular soil) Plant with the following: 25% Compost Manure 25% Peat Moss
